To All Members of Midland School Community,

This evening we were informed that an individual at Midland School has been in close contact with a positive COVID-19 case outside of school. Our school district has already been in contact with the Bergen County Health Department to address this incident. Due to the confidentiality of students and staff members, specific information about positive cases can not be released. However, the initial investigation has identified possible close contacts with multiple students.

Out of an abundance of caution, while awaiting further information, all in-person learning is cancelled tomorrow and Midland School will operate on a fully remote learning platform for tomorrow, Wednesday, November 4, 2020. This one day of all remote learning allows us to ensure that our school continues to be safe for our students and staff. Please know the district will continue to work closely with the Bergen County Health Department and to monitor this situation. The district will follow CDC, NJ Department of Health, and Bergen County Health Department guidance in order to ensure the health and safety of our students, staff, and community.

The district will continue practices for a thorough cleaning of all exposed and high touch areas throughout the district. The district will continue to communicate with health officials to implement contact tracing. We realize that this sudden change of schedule poses challenges for our families. The safety of our students and staff will continue to be our number one priority.

By Sunday a decision will be made regarding the status of a return to in-person instruction at Midland School and a communication will be sent to you on Sunday, November 8th. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation. We appreciate everyone's efforts to keep our community safe and healthy.
